The Northsea has become the biggest industrial area of the Netherlands - many companies are active in the areas of conventionals (oil, gas and LNG), renewables (mostly wind energy) and the offshore industry. Every market has its own experiences with arbitration. Some companies include an arbitration clause by default in their contracts and have a lot of experience with arbitration procedures, e.g. under the ICC and NAI rules or under ad hoc rules (like the terms of the London Maritime Arbitrators Association). Other companies have little to no experience with energy arbitrations but want to have a better understanding of this form of dispute resolution.

Within law firms there is a similar range in arbitration experiences: some law firms are specialized in energy arbitrations, others do it occasionally and then there are firms who want to be prepared for when such a case comes in.
